

Practical Information for Members

Court etiquette

Please wear non-marking footwear with a good grip (court surfaces may be slippery when wet)

Please do not bring chairs, bikes, buggies, etc, onto court (they may cause damage to the court surface)

If club balls are hit into the fields, please make every effort to retrieve them

Please show consideration for other members (no bad language, please)

Younger juniors should always be supervised by a responsible adult while using both the courts & the clubhouse/grounds. We ask that juniors should not be given use of a clubhouse key without supervision, even for table tennis.

Court Availability

We don't operate a booking system. **If players are waiting for a court, please restrict your play to 1 short set (ie. tiebreak at 5 all) or 20-30mins.**

Coaching times, match times & tournaments are usually displayed on the outside notice board &/or the website.

Matches take precedence over social play – 1 court will be available but please show consideration for the match players.

Social tennis on Mon & Fri evenings from 7pm onwards is for all adult & older junior players who can keep the ball in play in doubles.

Floodlights

Tokens can be purchased on social tennis evenings or from Sylvia & Yvonne. £1 per token which gives 30mins play. Floodlights must not be used after 10pm

First Aid

There is a First Aid kit in the lower left kitchen cupboard. Any serious injuries should be entered in the log book which is with the kit.

Guests

Adults may bring guests – please sign them in & pay £3 to a committee member asap. After 3 visits, we would expect the visitor to become a member.

Locking up

If you are the last to leave the clubhouse, please check that all lights are off & lock up securely.

If others are still playing, please make sure they have keys. If they are juniors you will need to lock the clubhouse for them.
